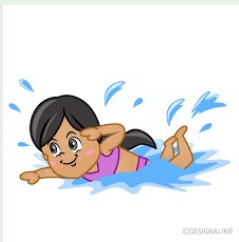
Our seeds we planted are continuing to grow in to seedlings and the children have made sure that they are watered every day.
