Literacy

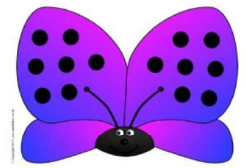
This week in 'The Wind in the Willows', we read about how Mr Toad went to prison and then escaped by disguising himself. The children imagined they were Mr Toad and wrote a diary entry. They then enjoyed creating disguises for themselves, and used adjectives to describe their disguise. We continued reading the story and ordered the events that happened to Toad on his journey.



Numeracy

This week we have been learning about Multiplication and Division through a range of activities. Children have continued to learn to:

- Count in 2s
- Recognise, make and add equal groups
- Make doubles



Topic

This week, in our 'Green Fingers' topic, children learned about the parts of a plant. They looked at different types of flower and dissected them to observe the individual parts. We also learned about why each part of the flower is important and what jobs they do.



Outdoor School
