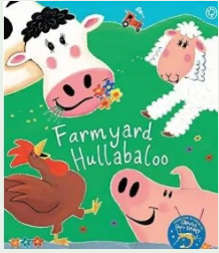


# Newsletter 22nd 2026 Class 3
