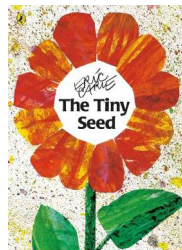
### Literacy

### Topic

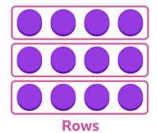
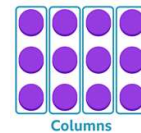
