In literacy we have been learning about poetry. We have been reading the poem *Hands* by Julia Donaldson and have been:

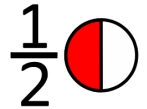
- ♦ Acting out the poem

- ♦ Recognise and find unit fractions

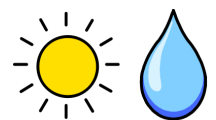


Some of us have continued working on time and have been:
