Numeracy

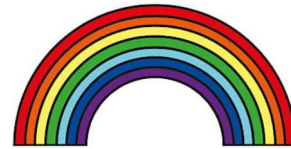
This week we have been learning about Fractions through a range of activities. Children have continued to learn to:

- Recognise and find half an object/shape
- Recognise and find a quarter of an object/shape
- Find a quarter of a quantity



Literacy

This week we continued our work on poetry, reading the Poem 'My Colours' by Colin West. The children enjoyed thinking about their favourite colours and identifying objects that are those colours. They then wrote their own version of the poem.



Topic

This week, we began our new Topic, 'Seeing the Light'. For our Entry Point in to this topic, children were given torches and went on a scavenger hunt in the darkened classroom to look for aliens that were hidden around the room. Children also enjoyed using the torches to explore shadows. We then looked at still life artworks, and children created their own still life arrangement from classroom objects and drew pictures. We looked at how to use pencils to shade dark and light tones, and children had a go at applying this to create light and shadow in their artwork.
