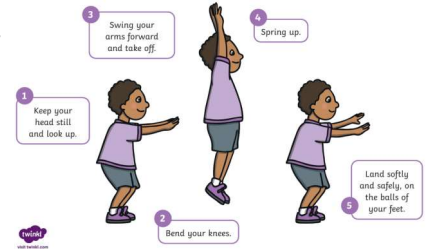

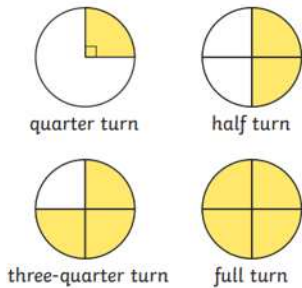
PE

In PE this half term our theme is Animal Olympics! This week we looked at dolphins and how they jump out of the water. Children practised the skill of jumping high, and they worked together to jump and reach the fish targets.



Numeracy

This week we have been learning about Position and Direction. Children have been learning to identify and describe quarter turns, half turns, and three quarter turns. We have been exploring this practically by turning our own bodies and using toys.



Literacy

This week we continued reading 'The Wizard of Oz'. Children looked at the good witch and the wicked witch and talked about how they were different. They then used adjectives to describe their appearance.



Outdoor School

This week in Outdoor School, we kept cool in the shade and listened to the book 'Pip and Egg', a story about changes in nature. Children also enjoyed drawing and colouring while relaxing under the trees. We then set out a water play area with coloured ice cubes with flowers and leaves frozen inside them. Children were very engaged in exploring the materials and they even began making magic potions!
