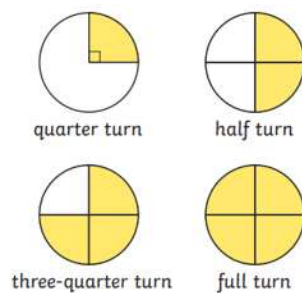
Outdoor school

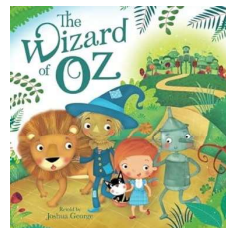
Numeracy

This week we have continued to learn about Position and Direction. Children have been learning to identify and describe quarter turns, half turns, and three quarter turns, through a variety of activities.



Literacy

This week we continued reading 'The Wizard of Oz'. Children enjoyed walking along our own 'yellow brick road' to read words from the story. We then continued reading and met the scarecrow. Children made their own scarecrow and ordered the instructions to show the process.



Topic

This week in our Topic, 'Seeing the Light', children learned about day and night. They used torches to represent the sun and globes to explore how the earth turns. They found different places on the globe and looked at when they would be experiencing night-time and day-time. We also learned about shadows, and experimented with shining the torches on objects to create longer and shorter shadows. We linked this to how the sun's position in the sky affects shadows throughout the day.
