Numeracy

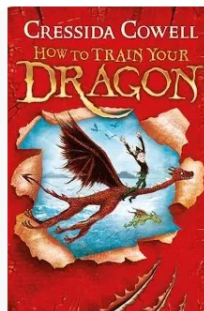
