Our Topic this Half Term is Active Planet. We will be learning all about natural disasters.

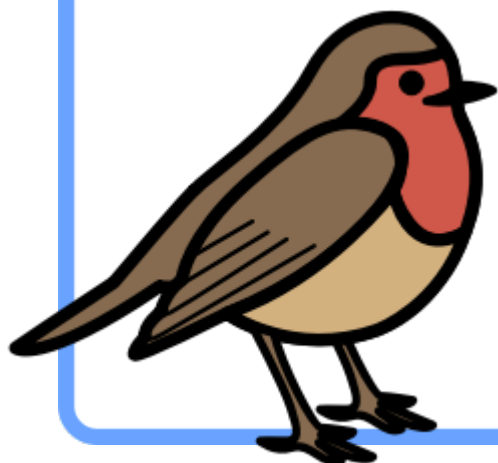
