



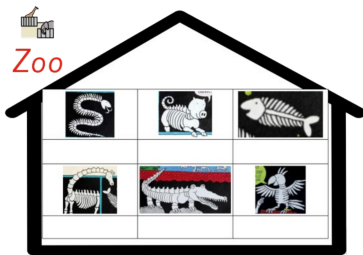

Literacy

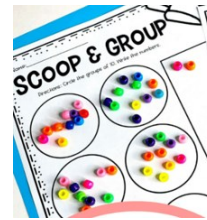
In literacy we have continued reading and finished our story *Funnybones*. We have been labelling images of different zoo skeletons and have been recalling the story events. Numeracy

In Numeracy we have continued working on number and place value. We have been:

- ◆ Finding and making the number 6
- ◆ Understanding 11, 12, and 13
- ◆ Grouping tens and ones
- ◆ Partitioning into tens and ones
