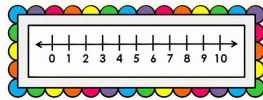
Topic

This week in Numeracy the children have continued their focus on Place Value. The children have been learning to represent different numbers. They have been using practical equipment and number lines. This focus will continue next week.

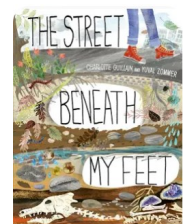


Literacy
