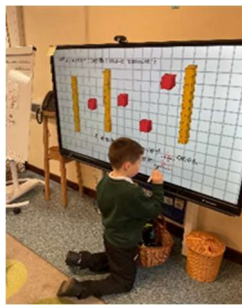

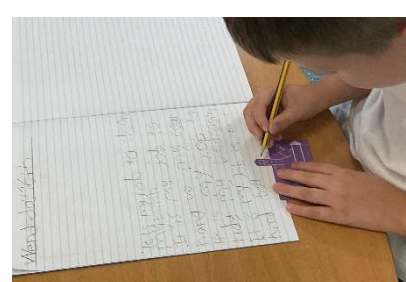
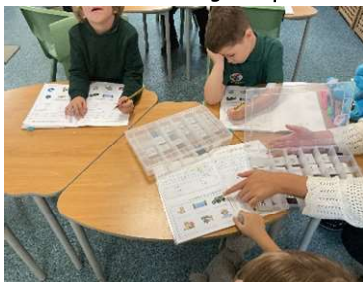
Maths

In numeracy, the children have continued to explore place value by partitioning 2-digit numbers.



Literacy

In literacy, the yr2 children have been working hard to form their letters to the correct size and orientation. While the yr3 children have been beginning to use cursive handwriting. This has been evident in their writing in phonics, literacy work and across the curriculum.



P.E

In both our ink and hub P.E, the children have been using their bodies to balance using 'point and patch.' This week, they have also explored counterbalances by pushing and counter tension balance by pulling.

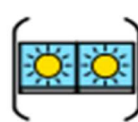
