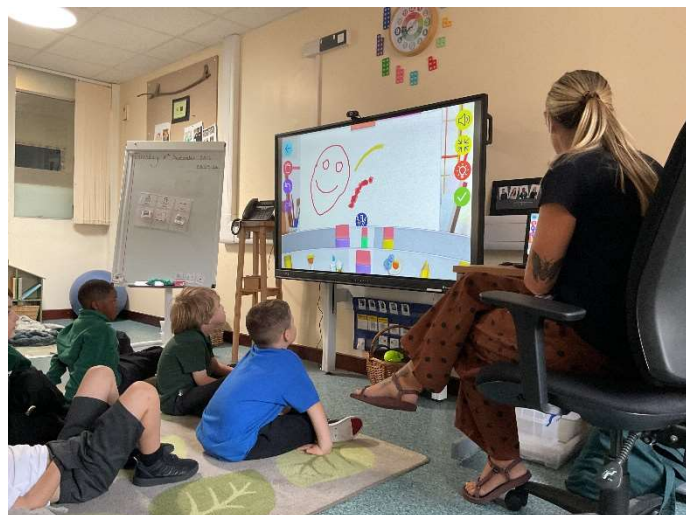

Hello and welcome to the KS1 Hub.

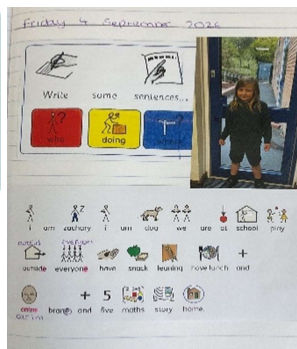
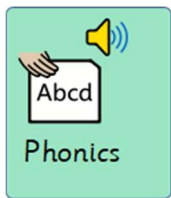
